*Knob Creek Bourbon, Carpano Antica, Angostura Bitters, Maraschino Cherry*



## Vesper Martini 10

Made to the specifications good enough for Mr. Bond himself.  
*Reyka Vodka, Citadelle Gin, Cocchi Americano, lemon peel*



## Fitzgerald 8

Once called the "Gin Thing" by King Cocktail, Dale DeGroff. First created in NYC in the 80's.  
*Long Road Dry Gin, Lemon, Sugar, Angostura Bitters, lemon peel*



## Brooklyn 10

Instead of traditional Rye whiskey, Añejo rum sounded more appropriate for this New York Borough libation  
*Brugal Añejo Rum, Plantation O.F.T.D. Overproof Rum, Dolin Dry, Maraschino, Grand Marnier*



## War of the Roses 9

A salute to our favorite bar in Chicago.  
*Pimms #1, Fords London Dry Gin, St. Germain, Peychaud's Bitters, Sugar*



## Mojito 9

Mint, sugar, lime, and seltzer were the original ingredients in this Cuban classic.  
*Plantation 3 Star Rum, Bacardi Limon Rum, Sugar, Lime, Mint, Club Soda*



## Daiquiri 8

Try it the way it was originally intended at the Floridita in Havana, Cuba 1934.  
*Plantation 3 Star Rum, Lime, Sugar*



## Old Fashioned 10

"What could possibly go wrong with an Old Fashioned?" - Tyler Fitzgerald  
*Maker's Mark Bourbon, Orange, Cherry, Sugar, Angostura Bitters*



## Tia's Sangria 10

Red or White  
This Spanish-born recipe dates back to precisely, "Back-in-the-Day". I think it was a Wednesday...  
*Wine, Contratto Rosso or Bianco Vermouth, Peach Schnapps, Brandy, Orange Juice, Pineapple Juice, Lemon-Lime Soda*



## A Latte Fun 9

A little sweetness, a little seasonal spice, a little jolt, a latte fun.  
*Kilo Kai Spiced Rum, VanGogh Espresso Vodka, Orchata, cold brew espresso, seasonal spice mix*



## Strawberry + Jalapeño Margarita 10

A pair as romantic as Romeo + Juliet. Subtly spicy, sort of like Mercutio.  
*Hornitos Reposado Tequila, New Holland Clockwork Orange, House-made Jalapeño infused sour, House-made Strawberry/Jalapeño Jam*



## D.C. 10

Think sweet Manhattan, up. Shout out to a fellow cocktail bar in D.C. for this magical potion.  
*Rittenhouse Rye, Benedictine, Pedro Ximenez Sherry, Cocchi Americano*



## Cafecito Frio 9

A tasty concoction inspired by brunching in Portland, OR.  
*Kilo Kai Spiced Rum, Fernet Branca, Becherovka, Coconut Milk, Sugar, Cold Brew Espresso*



## Orange Whip 9

A nod and a wink to John Candy in Blue's Brothers.  
"Orange Whip? Orange Whip? Three Orange Whips!" - Great for Brunch! Lookin' at you Mimosa drinkers!  
*Fords London Dry Gin, Plantation 3 Star Rum, Velvet Falernum, Orange Juice, Tang (Yes, Really!) Dale DeGroff's Pimento Bitters, Egg White*



## Blood & Sand 10

First appearing in the 1930 Savoy Cocktail Book, this was named for a 1922 bullfighter movie.  
*Denars Blended Scotch, Cherry Heering, Dolin Rouge, Orange Juice, orange peel*
